Digital Night School

Agranee has been running two "Solar Digital Night Schools" in Kaptipada block of Mayurbhanj district since 2016-17 with the support of Barefoot College International, Rajasthan aiming at provide digital education through applying modern technology for rural minds. Mostly out of school, dropout, irregular and working children belong to tribal communities are being provided free education during their leisure hours (evening) in both of the centers located at village Dileswar and Dukesahi under Ranipokhar & Dewanbahali GPs respectively. Apart from traditional TLM digital teaching learning materials like- Solar power run Projector and I Pads have been provided to the centres and adequate training to the local youths as teacher/facilitator. A total of 61 students continuing their studies in both the centers out of which 33 girls and 28 boys.

Beekeeping by Women Farmers

The overall objective of this initiative was to reduce gender inequality and improve quality of life by supporting poor and marginalized women to earn extra income through sustainable Beekeeping practices and marketing of bee products. This was a joint effort of Agranee and Barefoot College International, Rajasthan. This year we supported 30 women bee farmers from six villages with necessary equipment like- two bee boxes with bee groups, smoker, face safety mask, hand globes to each farmer including training. A total of 36 kg honey collected by the 1st year farmers during the year.

Marketing & Maintenance of Solar Products by Women Group

Agranee is also trying to promote marketing and maintenance of domestic solar products likesolar torchlight, lantern and home lighting systems in rural areas by a group of trained women. Mostly in rural areas where greed power supply is still irregular and inadequate. Under this initiative we provided solar products to the needy families at a subsidies rate with instalment facility including free repairing & maintenance facilities. This is also a collaborative effort of Barefoot College International and Agranee focusing on the empowerment of rural, tribal, low and semi-literate women. Under this initiative we have not only provided an alternative of power cut/shortage but also given an opportunity of extra income source for a group of 12 rural women in a entrepreneurship mode.

Covid- 19 Support Initiatives

After the outbreak of the ever worst pandemic of the world covid-19 Agranee also tried to contribute a bit for the relief of suffering mankind like other philanthropist organizations. As a response to such pandemic Agranee initiated the following activities in collaboration with Barefoot College International, Rajasthan:

- IEC campaign launched through social media. We have translated six video messages focusing on covid-19 Awareness, Symptoms, How it spreads, Precautions, Myths & Stigmas in odiya language and being forwarded those by creating a WhatsApp group of around 100 peoples mostly from rural areas that includes villager leader, PRI members, ASHA, AWW, Teacher and our community motivators/organizers those who have smart phones. Apart from forwarding we also gathering feedbacks from them and requesting to forward it further to their local contacts so that it could be reached too many more.
- 150 relief kits (ration items, sanitized items & Mask etc.) distributed to 150 needy families of Dileswar and Dukesahi villages of Ranipokhari and Dewanbahali GPs of Kaptipada block, Mayurbhanj disttrict during the pandemic.
