Digital Night School

AGRANEE has been running two “Solar Digital Night Schools” in Kaptipada block of Mayurbhanj district with the support of Social Work & Research Centre, Rajasthan aiming at provide digital education through applying modern technology for rural minds. Mostly out of school, dropout, irregular and working children belong to tribal communities are being provided free education during their leisure hours (evening) in both of the centers. Apart from traditional TLM digital teaching learning materials like- Solar power run Projector and I Pads have been provided to the centres and adequate training to the local youths as teacher/facilitator.

Beekeeping by Women Farmers

The overall objective of this new initiative is to reduce gender inequality and improve quality of life by supporting poor and marginalized women to earn extra income through sustainable Beekeeping practices and marketing of bee products. This is a joint effort of Agranee, Odisha and Barefoot College International, Rajasthan. It being the initial period of the project a group of 20 women bee farmers from five villages have been trained and provided with necessary equipments including two bee boxes with bee groups to each farmer.

Solar Electrification Initiative

AGRANEE is also implementing a solar electrification programme in collaboration with Barefoot College International, Rajasthan focusing on the empowerment of rural, tribal, illiterate and semi-literate women of Mayurbhanj district. This year we have identified and trained 12 tribal women/girl of Kaptipada block to carry forward the project activities in an entrepreneurship mode. Under this programme solar products like- Solar Torchlight, Lantern and Home Lighting Systems are being provided to the needy families at a subsidised rate with instalment facility.

Alternative Vaccine Delivery

This was the 7th as well as final year of the project undertaken by Agranee. Under this project we had taken the responsibility of delivering vaccine at 92 session sites of total Karanjia block covering all 22 ANM sub-centres as part of routine immunization activities under NHM. Giving necessary orientation, we have deployed six local youths dividing the entire block in six routes for smooth implementation of the AVD under the terms and conditions specified in the signed agreement by Agranee and MO/IC Tato, Karanjia, Mayurbhanj.
