## Digital Community School

Agranee has been facilitating three “Digital Community Schools” in partnership with Barefoot College International, Rajasthan aiming at provide digital education through applying modern technology for rural minds. Mostly out of school, dropout, irregular and working children belong to tribal communities are being provided free education during their leisure hours (evening in all three centers located at village Dilisar & Gadasahi under Ranipokhar GP and Dukasahi under Dewanbahali GPs of Kaptipada Block Mayurbhanj, Odisha. Apart from traditional TLM digital teaching learning materials like- Solar power run Projector and I Pads have been provided to the centres including adequate training to staff, teachers and parents. A total of 95 students from deprived tribal families continuing their studies in all three centers that includes both girls & boys.



## Beekeeping by Women Farmers

The overall objective of this initiative was to reduce gender inequality and improve quality of life by supporting poor and marginalized women to earn extra income through sustainable Beekeeping practices and marketing of bee products. Under this programme Agranee has enabled a total of 50 tribal women farmers to earn their livelihoods by providing remaining necessary equipment i.e. bee boxes with bee colony, smoker, face safety mask, hand globes and extractors etc during the financial year.

Approximately 120 kg of honey harvested and marked by the farmers at the cost of Rs.400/- per kg in the local market during the year along with their own consumption.

## Solar Electrification for Domestic Lighting

Two non-grid tribal dominated villages/hamlets namely Tenda comes under Saradiha GP and Purunapani comes under Sarat GP of Kaptipada block Mayurbhanj were provided solar domestic lighting systems by Agraneer in collaboration with BCI, Ajmer Rajasthan. A total of 100 solar domestic lighting systems were supplied to 100 non-electrified needy BPL families including training support under this initiative. One system contains one SPV panel of 40 watts, one tubular battery 12 volts, one electronic charge controller 10 amps, two/three LED lamps of 7 watts each & other accessories etc. As a result a renewable & sustainable energy source has been provided to the forest dwellers, which is maintained and afforded by themselves in a decentralized manner.

As a civil society organization Agraneer also tried to contribute a bit towards providing immediate relief and basic support to the worst affected communities of Mayurbhanj district Odisha. This being the 2<sup>nd</sup> & last year of the project a few remaining activities were successfully completed along with followup of the 1<sup>st</sup> year activities.

## Social Impact Assessment Study

In collaboration with State SIA Unit, Nabakrushna Choudhury Centre for Development Studies (NCDS), Bhubaneswar, Agraneer has conducted three Social Impact Assessment Studies(SIA) of private land acquisition for Re-Development of SCB Medical College & Hospital, Mangalabag Cuttack, establishment of Industry in Durgapur village under Jatni Tahasil of Khordha district and construction of Talcher- Sambalpur Rail Line Doubling Project under Banarpal Tahasil of Angul district Odisha during the year.
